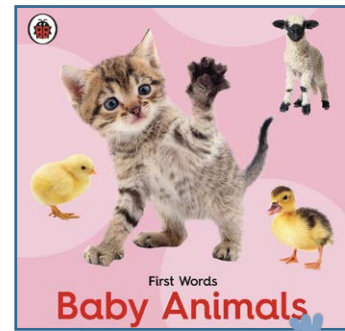

Using sounds is a great way to get your child excited about story time. This book is perfect for adding different noises to as you look at the animal pictures.

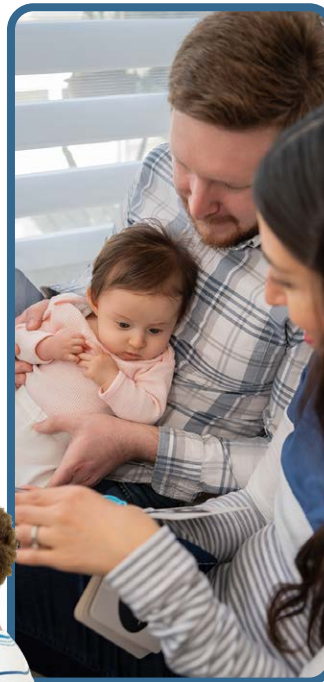
The next time you're in the library, why not see if you can find some more books about animals or vehicles. You could even make up your own story!
