From animals and vehicles to home, food and clothes...have fun naming the objects on each page.

Box Fun!

Find a cardboard box that is big enough for your child to sit in. Use items from around your home and other pieces of cardboard to make the box into any of the vehicles that your toddler can see in the book.

Talk to them as they get in and play at going on their adventure.

What noises does their vehicle make? What will the box become today? Is it a plane, a digger or a fire engine? Let their imagination take them wherever they wish!



Naming Pictures

Point to each picture and name the objects as you share the book with your little one. How much vocabulary a child has is very important to their future.

Research tells us that it affects their school performance. A child's vocabulary when they are five years old can tell us how well they will do at school when they are 11 years old.

Helping children to develop a good vocabulary is vital. By one year old children are usually saying single words although not usually pronounced correctly. By 18 months they may know **20 words or more!**
